Alfred University – Lelia E. Tupper Writing Scholarship

\$1,000 will be awarded for each of four years at Alfred University. Manuscripts must be submitted in both of the following categories: creative writing and expository writing. American Heritage Scholarship

The Island Christian Church will be awarding two \$1,500 scholarships to Long Island students whose lives exemplify genuine character and promote Scriptural values upon which our country was founded. Up to four \$500 High Honorable Mention scholarships may also be awarded. Selection of the winners will be based upon an essay written by the applicant as well as three recommendations. Boston University

*The Trustee Scholar Program recognizes students with outstanding academic performance and leadership ability. It is Boston University's most prestigious scholarship. Each Trustee Scholar receives a renewable scholarship covering full undergraduate tuition and fees for four years. Trustee Scholars are typically in the top ten percent of their class and are also very active leaders in their schools and communities. All necessary forms (including application for admission, nomination form, and essay and SAT/ACT scores) must be submitted to Boston University by **December 1, 2011**. Elks National Foundation Most Valuable Student Scholarship Competition

Any high school Senior who is a U.S. citizen is eligible. Applications may be downloaded at www.elks.org/enf/scholars. The application must be submitted before **December 2, 2011**. In addition, the Huntington Elks also administer the Roger E. Tetrault Huntington Scholarship which is open to high school seniors who are residents of the Town of Huntington. This program awards several \$4,000 scholarships. The due date is **January, 6, 2012**. The same application as the MVS Scholarship is used to award this scholarship.

Fairleigh Dickinson University

The Metropolitan Scholar Award is a full-tuition scholarship program for high-achieving students. The award may be renewed annually over the course of four years of study at FDU's Metropolitan campus in Teaneck, New Jersey. To qualify, students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher; rank in the top 10% of their class; have a minimum SAT score of 1300 (math plus critical reading), and apply as residential students at FDU's Metropolitan campus. Interested students must notify their guidance counselors that they wish to be considered for nomination. Up to three (3) students may be nominated per high school. The program is offered to academically exceptional students from traditionally underrepresented populations who have demonstrated strong character and leadership through service and community involvement. Scholars receive a minimum award of \$25,000. In addition to meeting regular admission requirements and deadlines, interested students must submit a separate scholarship application, essays and recommendation by January 15th.
