The use of alcohol and drugs by students is a major concern to parents and educators alike. Safe Homes was initiated as a national program to support and educate parents and children on substance and alcohol use and abuse. The program began at Harborfields High School in September 2000. As families joined Safe Homes, a membership list was developed and mailed to those who signed onto the program. The list was utilized by parents to communicate with each other about issues concerning community, school or social events. This program is nonjudgmental and not all families choose to enroll. The PTA certainly respects their wishes. Our goal is to maintain safe social settings for our children.

To join Safe Homes and to be included on the membership list, you will be asked to sign the pledge form below stating that you will not serve alcohol/drugs at your home, and you will supervise any social gatherings that take place at your home. You are not required to volunteer or attend any meetings. This program is meant to support and encourage communication between parents. Every member will receive a copy of the membership list.
