**Boston University**

*The Trustees Scholars Program recognizes students with outstanding academic performance and leadership ability. Trustee Scholars are typically in the top 1% of their high school classes with an average GPA of 4.0, a combined SAT score of 2289, and an ACT score of 35. In addition students must have made positive contributions to their schools and communities, have a record of volunteer service, and have excelled both in and out of the classroom. To be eligible, all candidates must be nominated by their principal or counselor and submit all necessary forms by December 1, 2009. **Coca-Cola Scholars Foundation**

*Scholarship recipients are selected based upon academic achievement, their capacity to lead, and their hours of dedicated community service. **Emory University**

*Harborfields High School may nominate up to 4 students for the Emory Scholars Program. Nominated students should have outstanding records of achievement, possess extraordinary personal qualities, and have made significant contributions to their class, their school, and their community. An essay is required. The nomination form along with the student's complete application for admission must be postmarked by November 1, 2009. Harborfields may also nominate 1 student with a strong interest in business. Deadline for receipt of this scholarship is also November 1<sup>st</sup>. ### **Gates Millennium Scholars**

*Students are eligible to be considered for a GMS scholarship if they: are African-American, American Indian/Alaska Native, Asian Pacific Islander American or Hispanic American; are a citizen, national or legal permanent resident of the US; have a high school GPA of 3.3 on an unweighted 4.0 scale; will be enrolling for the first time at a US accredited college or university as a full-time first year student; have demonstrated leadership abilities; meet the federal Pell Grant eligibility criteria; and have completed and submitted all three required nomination forms by January 11, 2010. ### **KFC Colonel's Scholars**

*Awards are up to \$20,000 for tuition, fees, textbooks, room and board. To qualify Seniors must: earn a minimum high school gpa of 2.75; enroll in a public college or university within their state of legal residence; plan to pursue a bachelor's degree; be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident; demonstrate financial need.
